## Sat. Oct 03, 2015

Tour Winnipeg, the wonderful city of trees! This tour includes the Forks National Historic site, Winnipeg's historical "meeting place", with its unique outdoor historic site and indoor market of shops, cafes, and restaurants. Across the Esplanade Riel Bridge, you will visit Winnipeg's French Quarter (St. Boniface) and the beautiful St. Boniface Cathedral, the oldest cathedral in Western Canada. The Cathedral's cemetery features the grave of Louis Riel, the famous Métis leader and founder of Manitoba. You will tour through the Exchange District, with its exceptional collection of terra cotta and cut stone architecture. This thriving and unique neighborhood is home to an array of restaurants, nightclubs, art galleries and Winnipeg's theatre district. You will also see the Legislative Building, the beautiful homes of Wellington Crescent.

#### Mon. Oct 05, 2015

Explore this award winning nature centre located within the city of Winnipeg showcasing more than 600 acres of prairie, bison herd, multiple lakes, forest and wetlands. On this tour, take a step back in time when the bison roamed the prairie and to a time when people's connection to the natural world was a matter of survival. Visit the Pioneer Sod House built from the earth, then stop by the bison viewing mound and discover the importance of this mammal to the Plains Cree. Explore the culture of the Métis, the influence they had on the fur trade, and their connection to the buffalo hunt. Following the tour there is time for lunch at Ft Whyte.

Your journey starts in the Wapusk Lowlands where you will see caribou, black bears, and grey wolves. The next stop on your journey will be the Gateway to the Arctic. Head inside a 10 ft acrylic tunnel and be surrounded by polar bears and seals as they swim and frolic in the clear water. You will then discover the Churchill Coast as the facade will make you feel as though you are actually transported to the town of Churchill. The landscape will include rocks, bear dens, and here is where you can encounter polar bears "nose to nose".

- 7:00 pm 8:30 pm Game 1 and dinner at the Seven Oaks arena following the game


